



## BRS-2 Class Exclusively for Cleveland Chapter H.O.G.



Per the Motorcycle Ohio website:

The Basic Riding Skills-2 (BRS-2) course is an intermediate-level, one-day (six-hour) ... course for experienced riders who wish to refresh and/or polish basic riding skills on their own two-wheeled motorcycle.

The BRS-2 is not for novices learning to ride.

This class will be held at Western Reserve Harley-Davidson at 8am on the date(s) decided by the chapter. The cost is \$100, payable at the time of registration. If we have 10 or more riders in the class, \$25 will be returned to each rider at the start of the class.

There are 2 Saturday's reserved for us at this time. If we have enough interest, we can run both classes. If we cannot fill both classes, the date with the most riders paid will be chosen. We can also run a class(s) on a weekday if we have enough interest.

The Saturday dates are: August 16, 2025 and September 20, 2025. If we add a weekday class, it would be a Tue - Wed- Thur in late August and/or September (decided by the chapter).

There are sign-up sheets in the Volunteer book at South East Harley-Davidson. If you are interested in taking this class, please indicate all the dates you are available when signing up. The dates that have the most interest will be filled first.

Once we set a date and confirm we have enough riders, we will collect the fees and lock in the registrations. This will be a first paid, first registered type event. Any fees collected will be returned in full if a class is cancelled due to lack of interest.

I would like to keep this entire process as timely as possible, if there is little to no interest by July 26, 2025 this class will be cancelled. This will allow members enough time to pay fees by the August 1st Cleveland Chapter H.O.G. meeting.
